## The Run

The Run in the Dark course is a certified 5K Course. The run begins on Bear Creek Parkway in front of Keller Town Hall (1100 Bear Creek Parkway, Keller, TX 76248) and goes East to the turn at Promontory Drive/Bear Creek Parkway, then returns to Keller Town Hall. The race will use a Chrono Track timing system (disposable D-Tags). Chips may be picked up on race day near registration with your race number. You must wear a chip to be timed and eligible for awards. Strollers and wagons are welcome. Dogs are not permitted on the course.

## Awards

The 1st overall male and female and the top three male and female finishers in the following age groups win awards for the 5K run: 9 and Under, 10-14, 15-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70+. 1-Mile Fun Run – first 1,000 finishers will receive a glow in the dark wrist band.

## School Competition for the “Storehouse Cup”

This will be our third year to award the “Storehouse Cup” to the school that has the largest school team participation. A school team consists of any child or adult that registers under that school name. The school with the most registrations for their team will be awarded the “Storehouse Cup” on stage and will hold the cup for the year at their school. Entries must be received by **Friday, September 10** to be counted toward the school competition.
